Family owned this delicious champagne is made with the classic grape varieties creating a fresh, lively and elegant wine.	
<b>Laurent Perrier Brut NV</b>	<b>42.00</b>
Hints of citrus linger in this delicate, well made, easy drinking champagne, Good on its own, with food or anytime – delicious.

<b>Taittinger Prestige Rosé NV</b>	<b>55.00</b>
Delicate salmon pink in colour and the aromas of wild strawberries, this Prestige Rosé is soft and elegant.

<b>Castillo Perelada Brut Reserva NV</b>	<b>17.50</b>
With aromas of citrus and wild flowers this lovely Spanish Cava is creamy soft and elegant.

## THE WHITE WINES

<b>Boonaburra Chardonnay 2010/11</b>	<b>14.25</b>
This full flavoured yet soft and elegant Australian white is pale straw in colour with the aroma of peaches and apricots.	
<b>Mezzora Pinot Grigio Garganega 2010</b>	<b>14.50</b>
Produced from grapes grown in the beautiful hills north of Verona, flavours of pears and summer peaches, gives a dry, fresh and stylish wine.	
<b>Añuela Sauvignon Blanc 2011 'Casablanca Valley'</b>	<b>15.00</b>
Just a few miles from the Pacific Ocean the Casablanca Valley produces some of the very best Chilean Sauvignon. The intense aromas of fresh herb and apple, together with the flavour of exotic fruits and ripe pineapple make this smooth, lively and distinctive zesty wine.	
<b>Matumi Chenin Blanc 2010/11</b>	<b>15.00</b>
From vineyards overlooking Cape Town and False Bay this Chenin Blanc is produced from bush vines where low yields ensure superb concentrated fruit, the aromas and flavours of peach and pear abound in this dry elegant and rounded wine	
<b>Viognier de Pennautier 2010</b>	<b>15.00</b>
An eruption of fresh peach, passion fruit and apricots in this smooth delicious wine made from grapes grown on the cool slopes of the Montagne Noir.	
<b>Cune Monopole 'Dry White' 2009/10</b>	<b>17.00</b>
This crisp and fresh dry white Rioja is made entirely from the white Viura grape. It has aromas of ripe citrus fruit and is the perfect partner for fish and seafood, or on its own any time!	
<b>Coleridge Hill 2010 'Three Choirs Vineyard'</b>	<b>18.00</b>
Three Choirs is one of England's best known single estates. Producing wines since 1975 this crisp dry white is a great example, in fact the perfect aperitif, it has the aroma's of wild elderflower and nettle with a clean fresh and lasting finish.	
<b>Runnymede Island Sauvignon 2010/11 'Marlborough'</b>	<b>18.50</b>
Bursting with green fruit flavours and a herbaceous twist this delicious thirst quenching Sauvignon is what New Zealand does best.	

<b>Mâcon Blanc Lugny 2009/10 'Les Charmes'</b>	<b>18.50</b>
This wine is produced in the heart of Burgundy from the Chardonnay grapes grown in the limestone hills near Mâcon, fresh full flavoured with a lingering finish.	
<b>Chablis 2009 'Le Classique' Pascal Bouchard</b>	<b>23.00</b>
This highly distinctive full flavoured classic Burgundy is from a family producer situated in the world famous village of Chablis. Only grapes from selected vineyards go to make this vibrant full flavoured wine which has the trademark minerality found in the best wines from this region.	
<b>Albarino 'Vionta' 2010</b>	<b>23.00</b>
From the cool north-western corner of Spain this very stylish delicate and fragrant wine is a must for those who have not tried it before, well worth the money.	
<b>Sancerre 2009 Clos des Bouffants</b>	<b>24.00</b>
Dry, fresh and well balanced, this full flavoured attractive wine is a constant favourite - a superb compliment to any fish dish.	
<b>Savigny Les Beaune Blanc 2004/07 Domaine du Château de Meursault</b>	<b>35.00</b>
Fresh 'peachy' Chardonnay with a crisp mineral edge from a village better known for its reds, this top property delivers what is excellent white burgundy.	

## ROSÉ

<b>Steenbok Pinotage Rosé 2010/11</b>	<b>14.25</b>
From South Africa, liquid strawberries and ripe cherries abound in this delicious elegant rosé.	
<b>Domaine Houchart Rosé 2010 'Sainte Victoire'</b>	<b>17.50</b>
Strawberry pink in colour this fresh elegant rosé has the flavour of ripe summer fruits with a hint of white peach. Soft and delicate from one of Provence's best properties.	

## AND THE REDS

<b>Boonaburra Shiraz Cabernet 2009/10</b>	<b>14.25</b>
Aromas of vanilla, cherry and ripe plums, this classic Australian red has the flavours of summer berries and just a hint of oak.	
<b>Mezzora Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2009/10</b>	<b>14.50</b>
Produced from the native Montepulciano grape grown in the central region of the Abruzzi. Deep in colour and robust in style, it has the flavours of dark plums and chocolate.	
<b>Añuela Merlot 2010 'Colchagua Valley'</b>	<b>15.00</b>
From vineyards situated between the Andes and the Pacific this handpicked Merlot has the aromas of plum and fresh mulberries. It is soft and elegant with the flavours of ripe berry fruits and just a hint of vanilla from its time in barrel.	
<b>Matumi Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon 2009</b>	<b>15.00</b>
The family owned property producing this wine was established just outside Cape Town in 1700, grapes are hand picked and the wine is aged in French oak which with refined soft tannins results in a wine with an abundance of blackcurrant fruit and just a hint of violet, it has a smooth lasting finish	
<b>Grant Burge '5 Generations' Cabernet Merlot 2008/09</b>	<b>16.50</b>
Deep crimson in colour with the aromas of ripe fruits, a hint of mint and subtle spices, the flavour is rich, luscious with black cherry and liquorice, an easy ready to drink wine from one of Australia's best producers.	
<b>Vondeling 'Baldrick' Shiraz 2009</b>	<b>17.00</b>
Young Southwest facing vineyards planted in one of South Africa's best independent properties make this delicious blend of mainly Shiraz, a hint of Mourvedre and a little Viognier. Clean, pure red and black fruits abound with just a hint of oak and a little spice on its smooth juicy lingering finish.	

<b>Runnymede Island Pinot Noir 2009/10 ‘Marlborough’</b>	<b>18.50</b>
New Zealand makes some of the best Pinot Noir, this new wine from a small family property on the South Island has the aromas and flavours of ripe black cherry. Soft, silky and lasting, with a gentle spicy character – drink cool, even chilled!	
<b>Rioja El Coto ‘Crianza’ 2007</b>	<b>18.50</b>
A quality oak aged wine from Northern Spain's best Bodega; it is distinctive with the flavours of ripe red berries and a hint of vanilla coming from having spent some time in new oak casks.	
<b>Fleurie 2009/10 Domaine de la Bouronière</b>	<b>23.00</b>
One of the most popular of the ten individual Beaujolais villages, this medium bodied wine has an intense raspberry fruit flavour and delivers excellent quality, try it slightly chilled.	
<b>Rioja El Coto de Imaz Reserva 2005</b>	<b>23.00</b>
A stunning quality wine from one of the best bodegas. Incredible fruit, good structure, this is one of the very best.	
<b>Château Devise 2005/06 Cru Bourgeois Medoc</b>	<b>25.00</b>
Classic Bordeaux from a relatively new family owned property. It has the aromas and flavours of ripe cherry and blackcurrant. Well made with good tannins and a rich elegance coming from its time in French oak.	
<b>Gigondas 2007 ‘Jérôme Quiot’</b>	<b>28.00</b>
The classic Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre blend from one of the Rhônes finest family producers. It is dark crimson in colour with the aromas of ripe berry and a little exotic spice, delivering a flavour that is full, rounded and packed with elegant fruit, giving a silky, long-lasting finish.	
<b>Château Bernateau 2006 St Emilion Grand Cru</b>	<b>39.50</b>
This property has been in the same family for two centuries, its vineyards cover 12 hectares in some of the best area within St Emilion. Deep ruby in colour with an elegant bouquet of summer fruits and just a hint of vanilla, well balanced with a lingering finish.	
<b>Gevrey Chambertin 2006 Patriarche Père et Fils</b>	<b>49.00</b>
The best of Burgundy, full bodied, rich with a velvety lingering finish, a good example.	
<b>Château d'Angludet 2003 Margaux</b>	<b>67.50</b>
Owned by the Sichel Family since 1961 Angludet is situated in the heart of the prestigious appellation Margaux. Rich round and full; this wine is drinking now but will age for 20 years.
